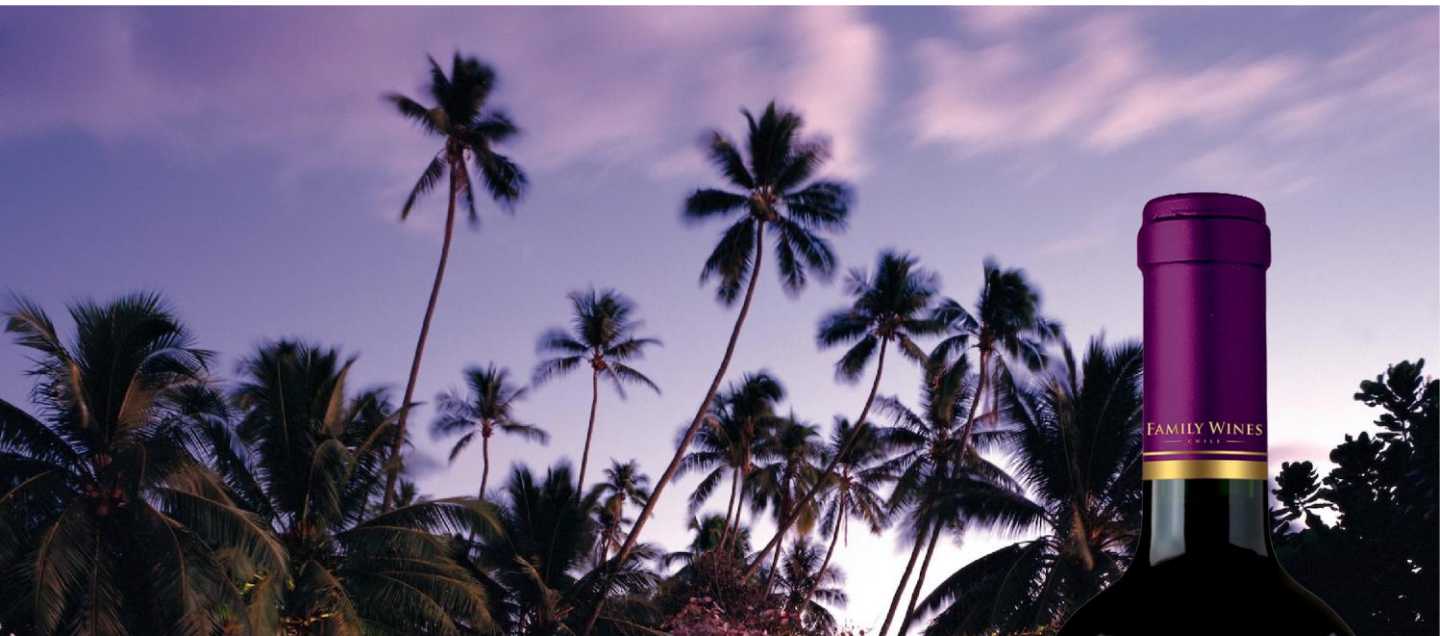


CASA PALMERA
